32. Pavilion Works

i. Electrical Works

The code 2 works (i.e. those identified as potentially dangerous for which urgent remedial action is required) within section K of the 2021 Electrical Survey (condition report number 8171) had been completed at a cost £485 +VAT, and a certificate would be issued. SSE had visited the pavilion and confirmed that no remedial work was required in respect of the EC15 earth clamp on the lead sheath.

ii. Legionella Risk Assessment Checks

It was Resolved – to authorise the purchase of an infra-red thermometer at a cost of up to £50 to undertake the calorifier water temperature checks in the loft.

iii. Trees at the Recreation Ground

An issue had been identified with regards the large turkey oak at the Recreation Ground on the boundary with Mill Road, and the debris it produces blocking the gutters of the houses opposite.

The annual tree survey is due in February 2022 although in the meantime the Council undertook to arrange an informal review by an arboriculturist to advise on what might be possible.
